AREA OF CONSIDERATION: Open to civilians who are eligible to enlist/commission before age 40 and current members of the Missouri Air National Guard in the rank of E-1 to O-3 and who meet the basic qualifications below

DUTIES: Orchestrates and standardizes logistics protocols, programs, policies and procedures for units at Whiteman Air Force Base and Jefferson Barracks Air National Guard Base. Ensure squadron members maintain the highest state of readiness to support state and federal contingency taskings and oversee the following core squadron functions of vehicle maintenance/vehicle operations; fuels; deployment and distribution operations; traffic management; and supply chain management.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Undergraduate or Graduate degree. Desired degrees: Petroleum Engineering, Chemical Engineering, Computer and Information Sciences, Computer Programming, Data Processing, Information Science/Studies, Computer Science, Computer/Information Technology Administration and Management, Engineering/Industrial Management, Economics, Aeronautics/Aviation/Aerospace Science and Technology General, Aviation/Airway Management and Operations, Business Administration, Management and Operations, Accounting and Related Services, Parts, Warehousing, and Inventory Management Operations, Business/Managerial Economics, Finance and Financial Management Services, Management Information Systems and Services, all other degrees may be permitted with approval.
- AGE: Be able to complete Officer Training School within a year of selection. (Prior service applicants will be considered up to age 39)
- Current passing FIT test (within 12 months)
- Current green ASIMS (medical)

EVALUATION PROCESS: Applications must be received by COB on closing date. Applicants are required to meet a board. Selectee will be assigned to compatible military position in the 131 BW at Whiteman AFB. Selectee will attend the AF/ANG commissioning program and will be required to attend technical school to obtain the 21R AFSC.
