SUBJECT: Environmental Commitment Statement

1. The mission of the 131st Bomb Wing, to include Lambert IAP and Jefferson Barracks ANG, is to train and equip skilled Airmen who provide full spectrum, expeditionary, B-2 global strike combat support capabilities to geographic commanders and the United States Strategic Command combatant commanders. The wing also organizes, trains, and prepares a community-based force of ready Citizen-Airmen to defend and serve the people of Missouri.
2. Regional/local environmental concerns are primarily centered around air quality. Therefore, accordance with AFPD 90-8, *Environment, Safety, and Occupational Health Management and Risk Management*, and AFI 32-7001, *Environmental Management*, the 131 BW intends to: (a) conduct its mission in an environmentally responsible manner, complying with relevant environmental laws and regulations, Executive Order, and DoD and Air Force policy, (b) continually improve in all areas, and (c) focus on pollution prevention through reuse/recycling, and use of environmentally-friendly materials and products to the maximum extent possible
3. This statement will be communicated to the public through posting on the wing's public website, to wing members by posting on unit bulletin boards, and in person to vendors and contractors upon contract award.
